

*All entries will be accepted on Saddlebook.com. If you prefer to pay by check, please ensure it is postmarked by August 11th, at the latest. For Zelle payments, use either vsolmonsen@aol.com or 801-910-3504. Alternatively, you can opt for the Credit Card method available on Saddlebook. Please note that payment is required to be included in the draw. After August 13th, you will need to use either Zelle or a Credit Card for payment. If you enter late on the

site, cash payments are allowed, but you must pay to be included in the draw. All late entries will be placed at the bottom of the draw and will be accepted until the race concludes.

- Important Guidelines for Participation**
- *W-9 Submission**
- The W-9 form must be submitted for the current year before any checks can be disbursed.
- *Horse Stalls**
- All horses must be housed in stalls; portable pens or tie-ups are not permitted.
- *Ground Maintenance**
- The ground will be raked every five runs, with a major drag every fifty runs. We will also rake between classes as necessary.
- *Timer Malfunction**
- In case of a timer malfunction, participants will receive a rerun with a clean slate.
- *Western Attire Requirements**
- Participants must wear western attire, including western boots, a long-sleeve shirt or pullover, and a western hat or helmet (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday).
- *Class Participation**
- A horse may not run more than once in any class.
- *Vet-Out Policy**
- A vet-out must be accompanied by a detailed description from the veterinarian. Vet-outs or turnouts will not be filled with late entries unless deemed necessary.
- A 70% refund on vet-outs is available until Friday the 22nd at 9:00 a.m. No refunds will be issued after this time.
- *Late Entries**
- Late entries will be accepted until the last runner completes their run each day.
- *Payouts**
- All added money will go directly into the payouts.
- *Average Awards**
- You must be present for average awards, or you may designate someone to collect them on your behalf.
- *Payment Information**
- Credit card payments will incur a 4% charge.

- All entries must be paid in full to be included in the draw; unpaid entries will be removed.
- Time-only runs must be paid for at the time of purchase.
- *Competition Venue**
- Events will take place in an indoor arena.
- *Event Details**
- Open 5D format with half second splits. Open 5D Average is on Saturday and Sunday races.
- Buckle Race is a carry over from the Open 5D. This is an 80% payback, and equal payouts on all 5 Ds.
- Youth 3D format is a 1 second split. Youth must be 18 or under as of January 1st. Average for the Youth is on the Saturday and Sunday Races.
- Senior 3D format, with a 1 second split.
- Open Pole Bending
- 2D format with a 1-second split
- Futurity: Carryover from the Open
- Open to foals born in 2020 or later
- Horses may not have competed in barrel races before November 15, 2024.
- No refund on Futurity entry fees; 2D format with a 1-second split, payout 60-40.
- *Maturity Event**

- Carryover from the Open, 5D events on Saturday and Sunday.
- 2D with a 1-second split.
- Horses aged 11 years and younger cannot compete in both Maturity and Futurity events on the same horse within the same year.

 - Open 5D Redmond Equine; combined draw for Open, Youth, and Seniors.
 - RUN FOR THE MONEY, \$250 entry, 90% payback, 5D, all 5Ds paid equally. No REFUNDS on this race, must run in Open 5D, late entries to the RUN FOR THE MONEY will run in your open draw and carry over to the RUN FOR THE MONEY. This is a continuous race, from all 3 days. Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Each horse and rider combination can enter once each day. Riders may enter as many horses as they would like.
 - Appreciation race, \$40 sidepot. Of the 30% held out I put back \$10 of the \$12 dollars for the Appreciation Finals to be held in November. You must enter 6 times to be eligible for the Finals, in November.
